

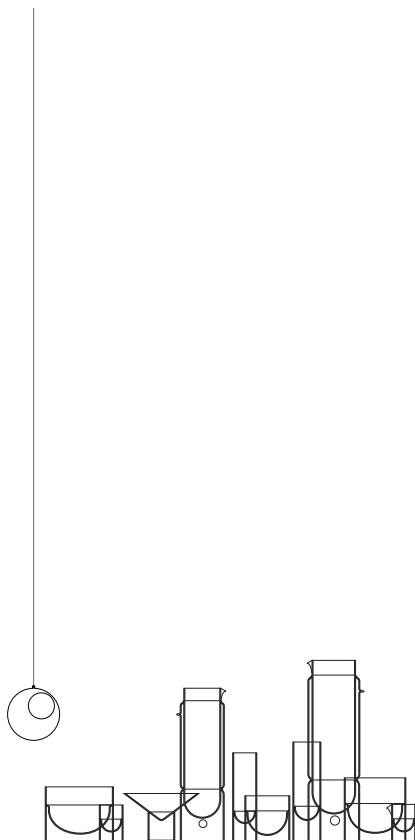

## float glassware



float is a line of thermally resistant glassware with simple forms and clean lines that emphasize the expressive colours and charms of the tea, spirits and other liquids within.

The glassware is handcrafted by master glassblowers in the Czech Republic from the finest borosilicate glass, an extremely pure and chemically inert material that is resistant to thermal shock. This allows float to be used safely with boiling hot or icy cold liquids.

The suspended bowl creates a lens of liquid colour, projecting hues of light onto the table below, and insulates your hands from your beverage. When used for a chilled drink, beads of condensation will gather on the underbelly of the bowl, adding delicacy to the optical effect rather than making rings on the tabletop.

float tea lantern, the collection's signature piece, is a tea pot named for the quality of light transmitted through the tea by the warming candle. The lantern is made with a double glass wall, enclosing a vacuum, to provide thermal insulation. The insulated wall allows for the simple form of a cylinder without a handle—simply hold and pour the way you would a wine bottle.

float matcha bowl is proportioned to accomodate the traditional bamboo whisk to froth the tea.



a candle under tea lantern keeps tea warm and creates a cylinder of coloured, ambient light.

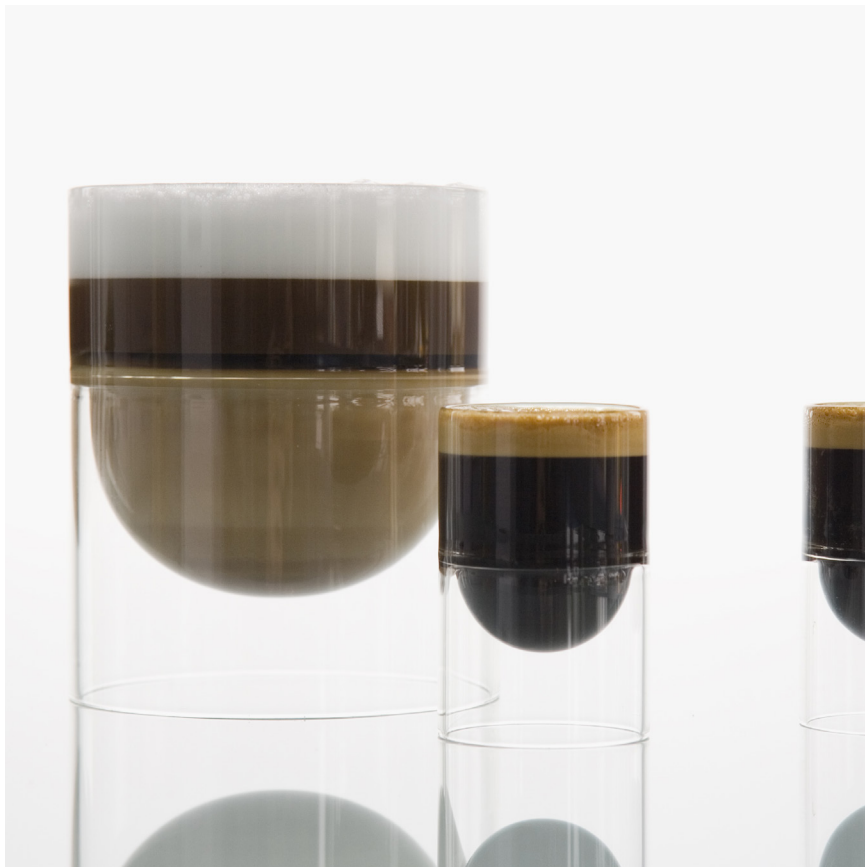


using the lantern to cold steep tea overnight creates a clean, refreshing iced tea. The inert quality of borosilicate glass allows for the purity of delicate tea flavours to surface.





warm your hands on the upper section of float or insulate from hot beverages by grasping below.



a liqueur glass used for a shot of chilled vodka on Saturday filled with the reviving drip of a Sunday espresso.



ice balls made from Japanese molds fit perfectly in float tea cups for a scotch on the rocks or other iced libations.



these 1.9 oz (45ml) glasses are perfect for liqueurs, espresso and sake.



float martini glasses harmonize with the aesthetics of the float collection, while preserving the classic shape of a traditional martini glass. The bowl and base are deftly attached as a single piece.





the clean lines and simple form emphasize the tones and tastes of the wine within. This is the most versatile size in the collection, with ample volume for a cappuccino, dessert or to let a Merlot breathe.



a contemporary champagne flute, lending clean lines and a fresh expression to a wonderful tradition. The glasses are also well suited for tall liqueurs, ice wines, or a single, delicate flower.





borosilicate glass is resistant to thermal shock and safe for oven use or with a crème brûlée torch.



orchids that photosynthesize through their roots excel in float.



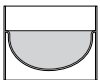




float bubble has two openings – a larger one to place a floating candle, and a small hole that provides airflow for the flame. Made in clear or translucent glass it can be hung on a tree, in a window or as a grouping to create a chandelier.
