



The dialogue of light, colour and emotion is an integral component in molo's ongoing investigation of multisensory space-making. Colour is more than an aesthetic choice in design, it is an experience, shaping the way people perceive and feel. When combined with texture and material, objects become a canvas for light to play on, shifting a single hue into a dynamic spectrum.

The sculptural form of softwall, with its rhythmic vertical fins and undulating folds, is the ideal instrument for this exploration, expanding the colour palette as if it were an organic, living form. Drawing inspiration from the natural world — where light refracts, reflects, and transforms colour — designers Stephanie Forsythe and Todd MacAllen have curated a series of limited-edition softwall colours, each selected for its unique emotional resonance.

Beyond these bespoke collections, we offer custom textile softwall in any Pantone shade, bringing any precise vision and emotion to life. Custom orders require a minimum production of 36 – 76 units, depending on the dimensions of the softwall. For smaller-scale projects, we provide a waitlist designed to align and group together clients considering similar Pantones.

softwall is an exploration of flexible architecture, expanding and contracting with ease. When compressed, each lightweight folding partition reduces to the thickness of a book. When unfolded and stretched, softwall smoothly extends up to 4.5 meters (15 feet) or adjusts to any desired length. As part of molo's modular collection of paper and textile folding furniture, softwall + softblock feature magnetic end panels that allow these flexible elements to seamlessly connect, forming expansive partitions and immersive, sculptural installations.


softwall printed in Pantone


The bright yellow glow of summer and sunshine.




Like fresh cherry blossoms, petal pink softwall (Pantone 12-1305) is surprising and joyful.



Colour is intensified by reflected light in the space between the pale pink petals of Peonies and Kikuzakura Cherry blossoms, creating a vibrant inner colour. The repeating pleats of softwall + softblock replicates this optic effect, allowing for striking and subtle changes in colour throughout the partition.



The pleated surface of the partition's lattice structure reflects light to create a stunning range of hues from saturated and luminous to a barely-there blush.



The uplifting shades of pink add another layer of softness to the acoustics and tactility of softwall, harmonizing the flexible concept, function and aesthetic.



A space composed with shades of pink brings out feelings of calm and joy.





softwall printed in Pantone PMS Warm Grey 1 sits at the threshold between softness and structure, evoking the gentle patina of weathered stone.



softwall printed in Pantone PMS Cool Grey 6.





softwall printed in molo red (Pantone PMS 200) is luscious and bold, immediately invigorating its surroundings.



Red evokes more than a deep emotional response; it recalls larger cultural traditions. A shade of good fortune, prosperity, and power, its richness tells a different story depending on place and context.
